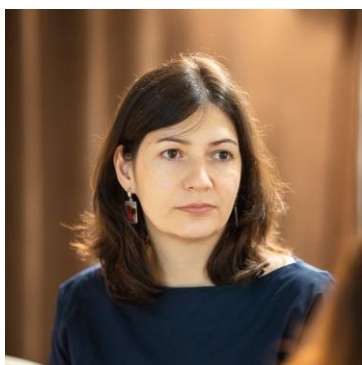

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Areas of Experience

15 years of research experience in sociology and oral history. 12 years of teaching experience at the National University of Kyiv-Mohyla Academy. 12 years of experience in non-governmental organizations in the cultural sector: project management of cultural, publishing, archival, and research projects. 4 years of successful work as a fundraiser. The combination of these different activities contributed to the formation of such personal qualities as analytical thinking, responsibility, the ability to work both independently and in a team, the ability to effectively organize time and coordinate the work of others, the ability to meet deadlines, and multitasking.

Most of the research projects I have participated in and managed are based on qualitative sociological methodology and are related to the study of traumatic experiences (the Holocaust, the Revolution of Dignity, the Russian-Ukrainian war, the needs of people living with HIV and people who inject drugs, etc.) Accordingly, I have extensive experience working with sensitive topics: developing methodology, conducting in-depth interviews based on the approach of active uncritical listening, and analysing the collected data. At the same time, since my master's studies, social structure, stratification, and educational inequality have been in the focus of my research interests. And during Russia's full-scale war in Ukraine, I also began to research the issue of Ukrainian Academia in war.
